Scripture:

John 19:17-30; Romans 3:23, 6:23; Genesis 2:25, 3:9-10

Ice Breaker:

If you had never heard the word, *Tetelestai*, before, what do you think it would mean?

Message Notes:

CONSIDER THIS:

- The cross is the central point of Christianity
- Tetelestai: Greek for "paid in full"
- Jesus completed of redemption and because of this redemptive act we have a brand new life
- When he died, we came to life.
- Jesus once for all settle it. Forgiveness for our past and hope for our future.
- We cannot complete a complete work. We cannot finish a finished work.
- Jesus paid it all. We don't have to seek for approval, we came from a place of approval.
- His blood washes off our sins. Sin is finished. Shame is finished. Condemnation is finished

- What is the one thing in today's message that resonated for me?
- When I think about the cross of Jesus, what does it mean to me?
- What is the one thing that is revelatory around this thought of the cross and *Tetelestai*?
- How do I know that I'm honoring Jesus and his cross in my life?
