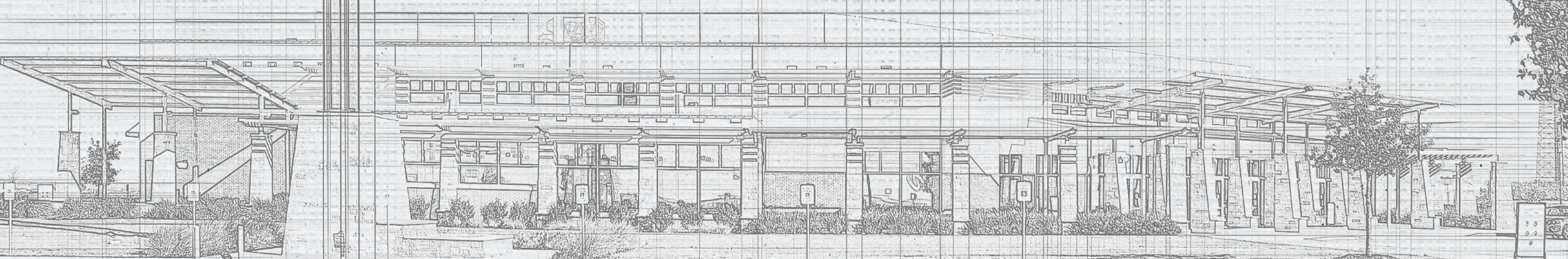
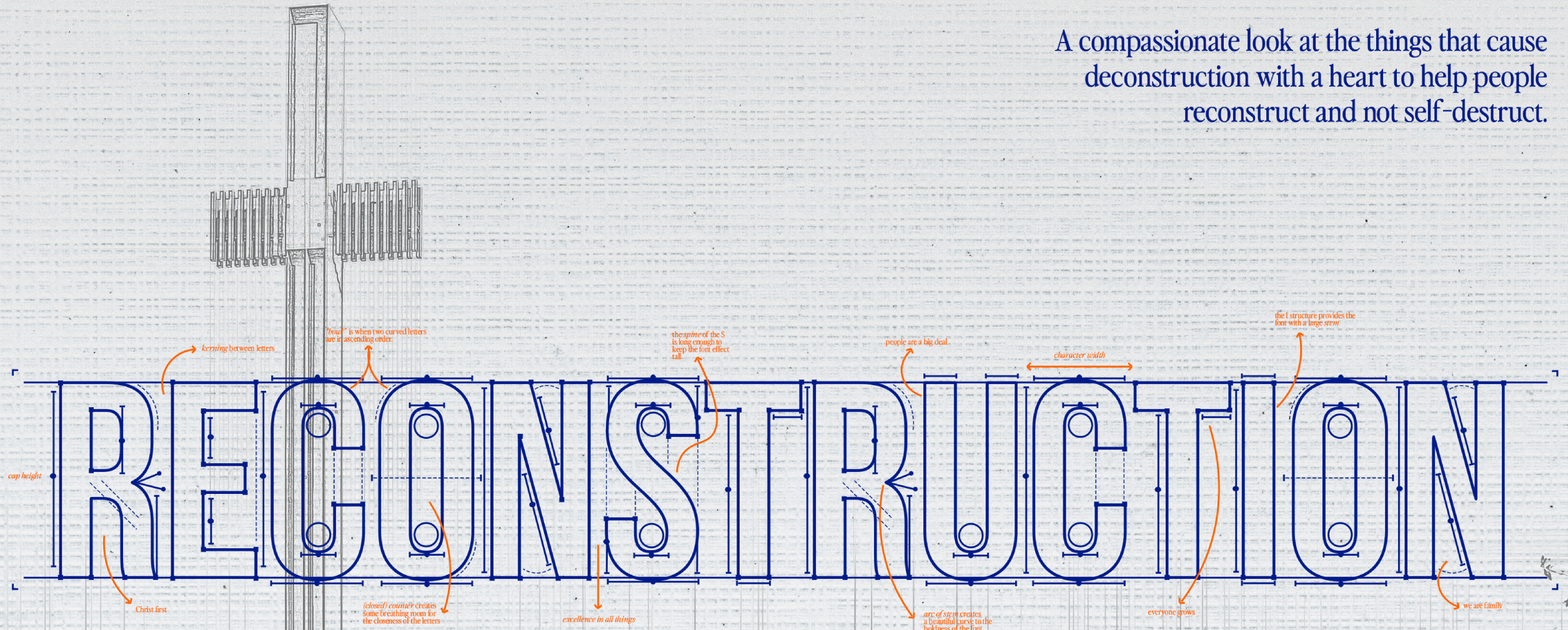

Scripture: Acts 27, 2 Cor 11:24-31, 2 Cor 4:7-9,
2 Cor 4:7-9, 1 Pet. 5:10

Ice Breaker: Have a group member look up/play “I Speak Jesus” and spend a few minutes praising and worshiping God together.

Message Notes:

It will be as He said it will be

- Creation - Fall - Jesus = Restoration and New Creation
- Trust who God is
- Trust Him at His word

Prayer:

Holy and Mighty God, we thank you for your word that is our anchor in the world. We thank you that despite what we may endure, it will be as you have said it will be. Help us to turn to you with our difficulties and trouble and seek your word for understanding. Lord, I pray your peace that surpasses all understanding would be ours and that even in our difficult times we would carry your joy and the hope of your salvation to the world around us.

Questions:

1. We all experience suffering and pain, discuss how we respond in the flesh. Recite John 3:16 together and discuss how we can stand on this to work out our emotional responses with God.
2. Read Acts 27 together. How does Paul trust who God is and trust Him at His word? Share together “shipwreck” experiences you’ve had with God. If a group member is currently in one, take time to pray over them
3. Read 2 Cor 4:7-9, 1 Pet 5:10, Rom 15:13. Discuss the hope, the anchor, we have in Christ, despite what we will face as we go about life.
