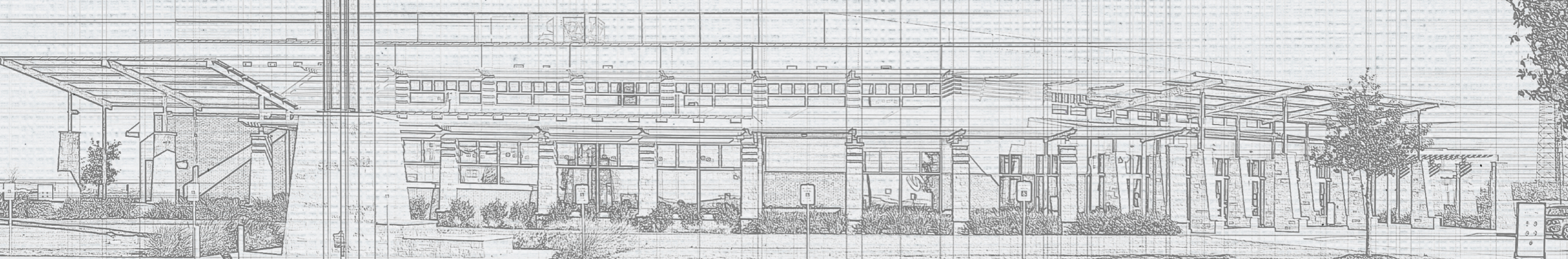
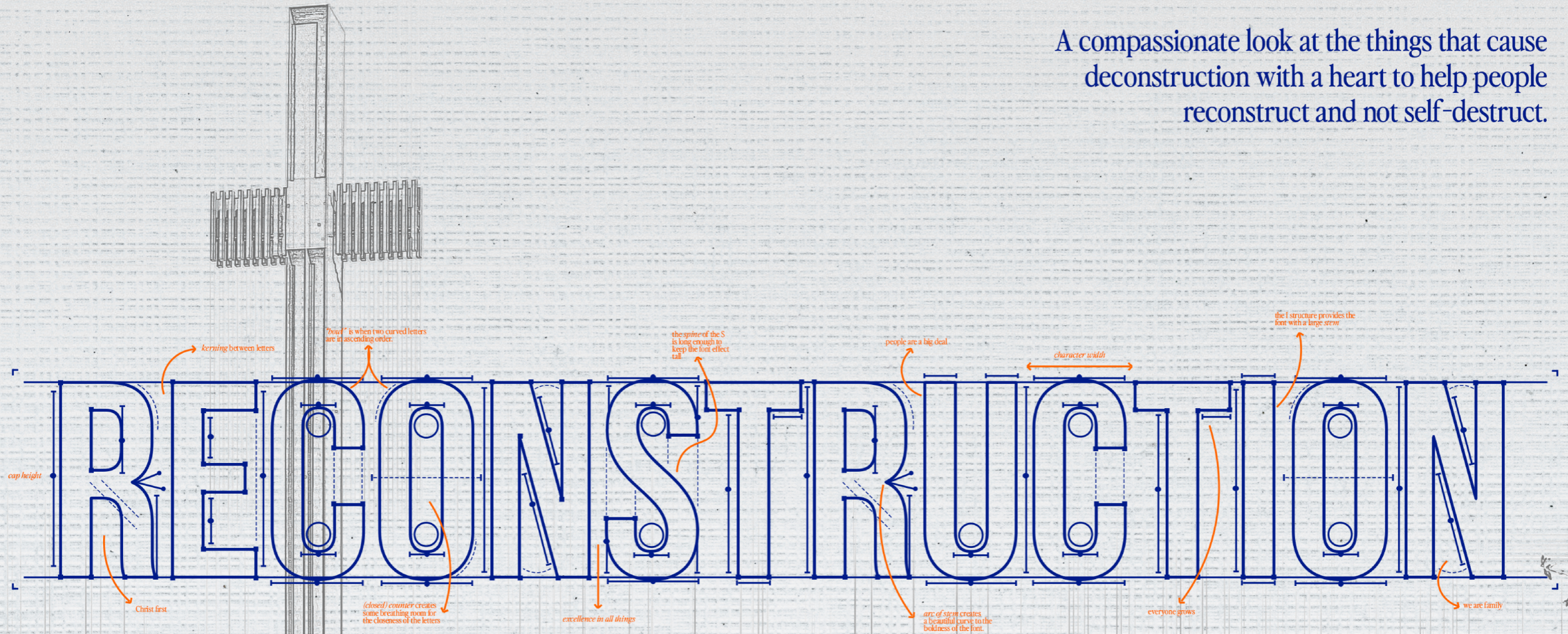

Questions:

1. God sometimes uses the ordinary, to usher in the extraordinary (David bringing bread and cheese in this story, but later becoming King in another). How has God worked in this way with you?
2. Ps. Joe taught us from this story that there will be circumstanced, Sauls and/or Goliaths that try to defy the God call on your life. Have you experienced that? How did you cling to God?
3. Ps. Joe mentioned that we are each born an original, so we should stop trying to be a copy. What makes you uniquely “you”? If you were to live life to the fullest embracing that quality, what might you change?
4. In 1 Samuel 17, it was David’s trust/remembrance on the Lord’s faithfulness to deliver him from the lion and the bear that built faith to defeat the Philistine. What are the moments of God’s faithfulness in your life that could give you faith for your future?
