

### **BIGIDEA**

When you see the words "The Cross," what comes to mind? Is it a memory from a family member's house with one hanging on the wall? Or an elaborate stained-glass window in a church?

Whatever you envision, the cross is the defining picture of our faith. Why did Jesus have to die on the cross, you may ask? The cross in biblical times was a place where they executed criminals. The Roman empire would utilize crosses as public execution to show their ultimate authority and as a scare tactic for anyone that would come against their "kingdom." This is important for us to know because this was done by design and allowed by God. The cross is not just a happenstance because of what



was culturally done at the time; the cross is a fulfillment of prophecy and shows us God's heart. I want to take you through three things about why Jesus dying on the cross is essential for us as Christians.

- 1. Our debt has been paid Romans 6:23
- 2. Death has passed over us 1 Corinthians 5:7
- 3. Our future in Jesus is greater than our past 2 Corinthians 5:17
