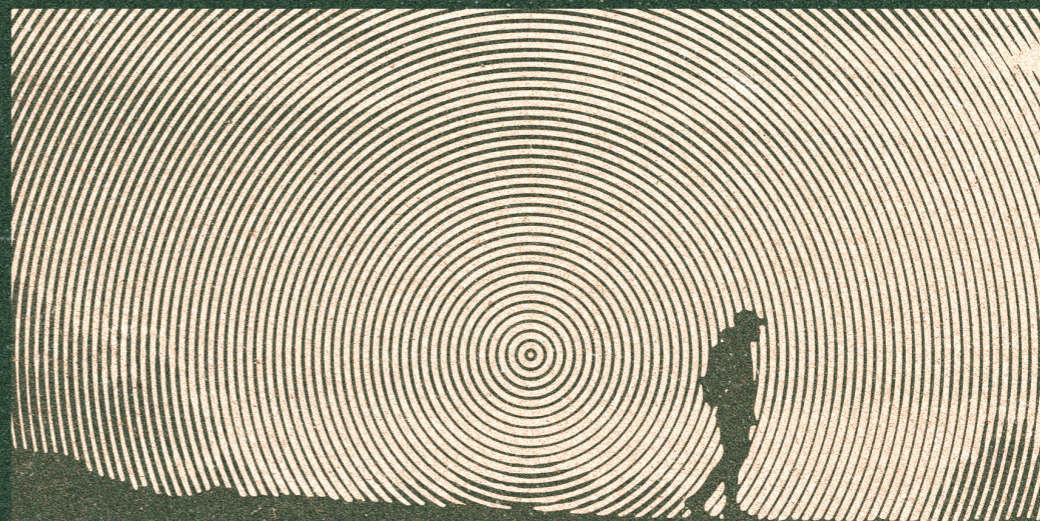

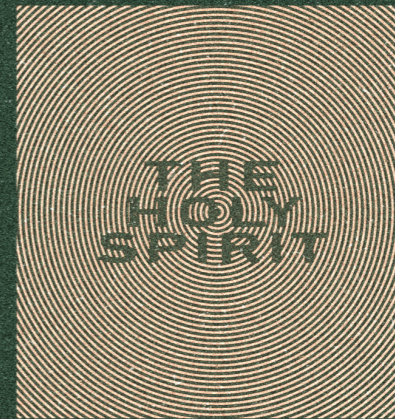

1. He will help you - John 14:16

5. He will keep you grounded in Jesus - John 15:26
6. He will bring conviction - John 16:8-10
7. He will guide you into all truth - John 16:13
8. He will speak to you - Acts 13:2, Ezekiel 47:9

Questions

1. In Ps Joe's message he mentioned that when we are baptized by the fire of the Holy Spirit, we start to experience more of God in our lives. What are some ways you believe that these experiences can occur?
2. The Holy Spirit will always be there to help us. This may come in the form of Him guiding us, but it can also be when He convicts us. Can you think of a time when He did either one of these things? Or both?
