2. Ps Joe shared about a conversation he had with Mark Green who owns Hobby Lobby. He was struck by the statement Mark made about his father who launched the company who said, "I was anointed to be a merchant". Many of us attribute being anointed with being a pastor, a leader, or a worship leader. Thinking of your own job and work environment, how have you been personally anointed by God to work where you do? Everyone take a turn and share.

3. We all heard a different angle in the life of Gideon today as we learned of him "working" to thresh the wheat in a winepress because it was a safe place. One of the things Ps Joe mentioned was that Gideon was "grinding it out in a place he never wanted to be". Have you been there with your job? Where you hate it but you are there anyway? How do you endure each day?

4. God partners with passionate people. Epaphrus was passionate and fervent (See Colossians 4: 12-13). Work is not a place where most of us feel "passionate". Think about your work and name 3 things that you enjoy or know that you do well there. This is a start to becoming passionate.

5. In Mark 9: 23-24, Ps Joe invited us to think about these words, "I believe in you, now help my unbelief". Working while we are suffering, or not enjoying it, or wondering what we will do next is hard when we know God made a way for us to be there. What area of unbelief are you struggling with and why?
